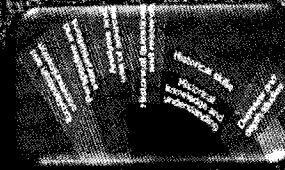
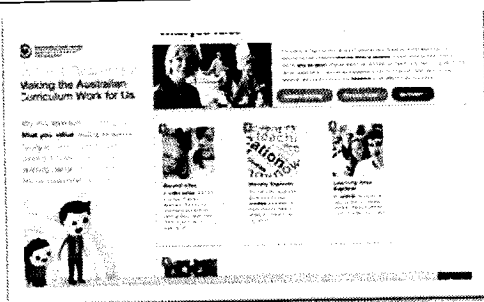


# Cove Cluster School Closure 29<sup>th</sup> April
